WHAT IS A TYPICAL RACE DAY LIKE?

Morning

Arriving early, you will pick a spot to park, unload your kart, tools, etc. and prepare yourself for the day.

Registration usually begins at about 8:00am. You will pay your race day fee, pick up your wrist band, transponder and pre-tech sheet and sign a waver.

Pre-race technical inspection begins shortly after that and the drivers meeting will take place before on-track activities.

Once you have prepared your kart and climbed into your suit, you're ready to hit the track.

Practice sessions begin around 10:00, followed by qualifying. Timed qualifying will determine the starting order for the pre-final races.

Sometimes we do random drawn heat races - great for race craft.

Each class usually runs separately, but some classes may combined during the day.

Afternoon

After a lunch break, you will gear up for pre-final races.

The finishing order of the pre-final determines the starting order for your final race.

Once all the pre-final races are complete, the final races take place.

Will you be taking home a 1st place trophy?
